Memorandum of Understanding on the responsibilities

The following are the points of responsibilities between the two institutes for the fruitful completion of the collaboration

1. The students of DLIHE will stay through out in Tarab Ling.
2. The whole program is divided into 3 components as follows:
 - 1.1 Component 1: 1st January to 15th February 45 Days
 - 1.2 Component 2: 16th February to 31st March 44 Days
 - 1.3 Component 3: 1st April to 15th May 45 days
3. Tarab Ling will take the responsibility in the first two components carrying 50% marks in total. Each component will carry 25% following the above time line. Tarab Ling will give marks out of 25% in each component following the instructions in the table below provided by DLIHE.

4. The procedure and the method of giving marks in both the components are the same.
5. Tarab Ling will maintain an attendance register and the procedure for giving the attendance mark of 3 is as follows:
Attendance -85=0., 85-90 = 1, 90-95=2, +95= 3
6. Students have to write 3 papers in total during the entire period. Two papers are in Tibetan and have to be sent to their respective teachers in DLIHE following the above time table.

Apart from proving their understanding of inner-Science, a paper in English has to be written which will start from 1st April where the focus is on improving their English writing skills.

7. All the papers will be sent by the DLIHE students to their respective teachers who will evaluate and give marks. Tarab Ling therefore has no responsibility over evaluation of the papers as well as giving marks on the papers.
8. The 1st paper will be on any topic chosen by individual students in their 4 years of Bachelor's Degree. The thesis/ papers should not be less than 35 pages and not more than 50. The size of the papers and the fonts should be the same as per the guidelines.
9. The 2nd paper is on their learning experience in Tarab Ling
10. The 3rd paper is on any topic in English by students' choice and they will send it to their respective teachers in DLIHE similarly as in the case of the previous two components. The paper does not necessarily have to be on UD. It is greatly appreciated from DLIHE that the Tarab Ling teachers assist them in improving their English writing skills.
11. The total number of credits required by a student is 20 for the whole course, and it is at the discretion of Tarab Ling how the credits should be divided between lecture, tutorial and practical.
12. Tarab Ling could but don't have to apply this same credit system as well as the marks to the western students too.
13. The total number of credits/marks given to the Western students will be sent by Tarab Ling to DLIHE and accordingly DLIHE will issue the certificates to the western students.

In Nutshell,

- Tarab Ling will give marks only in the 1st two components (50% total) following the above stated marking instruction.
- All the three papers DLIHE students have written will be sent and evaluated by their respective teachers in DLIHE
- The topic of the papers will be chosen by the students themselves within the frames given above
